St. Patrick's Day Parade of Morris County, Inc. Rules and Regulations for Parade participants

1. PARADE MARSHALS ARE TO BE OBEYED AT ALL TIMES

- 2. Any individual who operates a vehicle in the parade must possess a valid driver's license.
- 3. No unscheduled stops or pauses in the parade "Line of March" are permitted.
- 4. All participants are expected to abide by general behavior guidelines. The St. Patrick's Day Parade is a Family Friendly event. Alcohol is strictly forbidden along the parade route.
- 5. The Parade Committee does not endorse any Parade contingent. Campaigning and other political activities are against Parade protocols. No political, commercial, fundraising activities, no campaign buttons, signs or apparel will be allowed. Only politicians who currently hold an office will be accepted.
- 6. Parade Marshals have the right to inspect all banners/signage and flags, and reserve the right to eliminate any entry that is in violation.
- 7. All organizations with animals are responsible for immediately curbing/cleaning up as necessary. In addition, all animals must be of nature so that noise and excitement will not frighten them.
- 8. The tossing of candy or any other objects to the crowd is strictly prohibited. Any giveaways or candy must be handed directly to the attendees.
- 9. Entries with children under the age of 19 must have adult supervision.
- 10. The Parade Committee reserves the right to limit the number and type of vehicles and other entries in the Parade. Vehicles without a Parade Pass will not be allowed into the staging area.
- 11. No drones or similar devices may be used along the Parade route.
- 12. All marching groups are to stay in formation until reaching the Parade end at Morristown High School. Groups who fail to do so may jeopardize their future parade consideration.
